The Vision Gallery is a cultural center in the heart of Downtown Chandler, a place where art is integrated into our community.

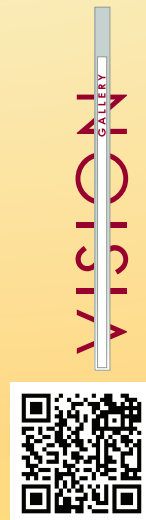
It is a place where everyone is welcome and those who enter the door are always amazed to find a facility like it nestled in Downtown Chandler.
